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ACTIVITIES INFORMATION SHEET

We would like your program to run smoothly and efficiently and to this end advise the following:

Camp Kookaburra will provide three activities staff and normally those staff will conduct canoeing, abseiling and the flying fox, in conjunction with a staff member from your School. Each of the other activities can be run by one leader from your School, although we recommend that you supply two leaders to efficiently run the indoor climbing activity.

For safety reasons we strongly recommend that you allocate an activity to each of your team and that they run the same activity for the duration of the camp.

Please ensure that you arrange activity groups in even numbers.

Shortly after your arrival at Camp, Kookaburra Staff will teach your Leaders how to run the activities they have been allocated to.

We will provide detailed instructions and demonstrations to each activity leader as well as written procedures where required.

It is also advisable that your students are made aware prior to the camp that it is essential that they wear correct footwear for all activities, ie: lace up runners, not thongs or slip on shoes/sandals.

Also please advise your students that anyone with long hair has it tied back and that necklaces, large earrings and rings are not appropriate whilst participating in activities.
